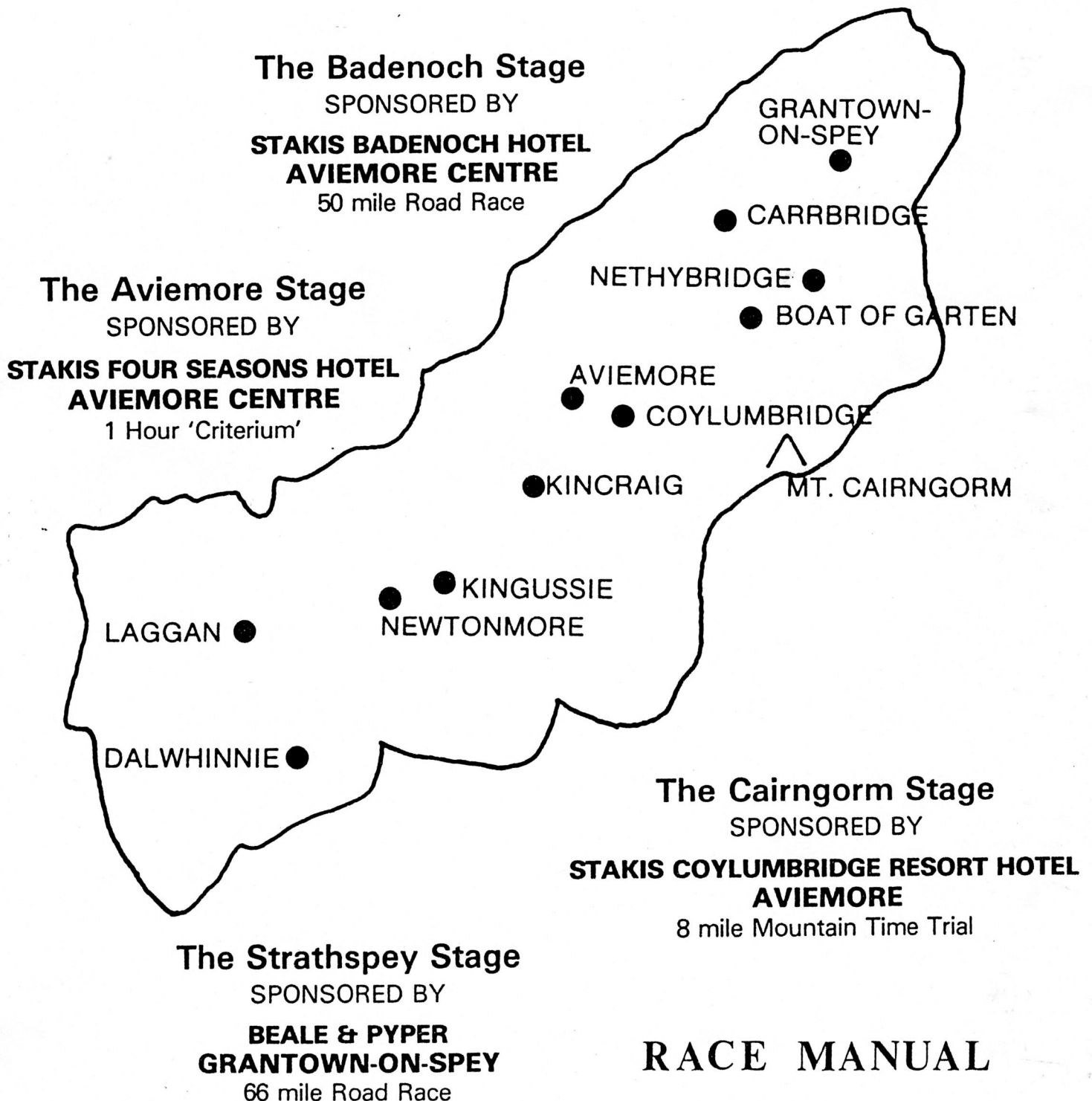

STAKIS TOUR OF SPEYSIDE 1987RACE REGULATIONS

The Stakis Tour of Speyside is run under the rules of the Scottish Cyclists Union together with those rules specified within this Manual and registration for this event signifies acceptance of same.

All Competitors, Team Managers, Race Officials, Drivers, Marshalls and Helpers must register for this event by signing on. Competitors sign on prior to every stage.

Race Control for Stages one, two and three is at the Reception Area, Aviemore Centre (South Entrance) and for Stage four at the Woodshed Bar, Stakis Coylumbridge Resort Hotel. This Hotel is 1½ miles from Aviemore on the Cairngorm Road.

Race H.Q. - The Badenoch Hotel, Aviemore Centre. (Tel. 0479 810261)

A Race Meeting will be held in the Highland Room, Reception Area, Aviemore Centre, on Friday evening 19 June at 9.00pm. All Team Managers, Race Officials, Drivers, Marshalls and Helpers are asked to attend.

Changing Accommodation prior to Stages one, two and three will be in the Highland Room, Reception Area, Aviemore Centre and prior to Stage four will be at the Woodshed, Coylumbridge Hotel.

Showers will be available after Stages one, two and three at the Swimming Pool, Aviemore Centre, and after Stage four at the Swimming Pool, Coylumbridge Hotel.

NOTE - These facilities are for competitors only.

Unauthorised following cars are prohibited.

Prize presentation - Stage winners will be presented with winners sash immediately after stage finish. Points leader will be presented with Leaders Jersey immediately after finish of stage. Stage four winner will be presented with winners sash at final prize presentation.

The Final Prize Presentation will take place at 17.00 in the Cairngorm Suite, Coylumbridge Hotel.

High Tea will be available in the Cairngorm Suite from 16.00 - 18.00. High Tea will be free to all competitors, Family and Friends at a subsidised rate of £2.75 per person. It is essential that advance notice is given for High Tea. Tickets can be obtained at Race Control prior to Stages one, two and three.

Race Service - Griffin Cycles, Inverness, is supplying one Service Car. Team Managers are asked to volunteer and supply Service Cars. Each Rider to supply one RACEWORTHY wheel - odd numbers a front wheel, even numbers a rear wheel.

ALL RACE SERVICE TO BE STRICTLY NEUTRAL.

Riders not in Club teams may be grouped into composite teams.

STAKIS TOUR OF SPEYSIDE 1987RACE REGULATIONS

Competitions - General Classification.

Bonuses - Stages one, two and three - 1st. 10sec., 2nd. 6sec., 3rd, 4sec.
NO BONUSES FOR STAGE FOUR

"Osprey Challenge" Points Competition.

Points for Prime - 1st. 4 points, 2nd. 3 points, 3rd. 2 points.

Points for HOT SPOTS - 1st. 3 points, 2nd. 2 points, 3rd. 1 point.

Stage one - Kincaig Prime, Newtonmore Hotspot, Kingussie Hotspot.

Stage two - Hotspots at 15, 30 and 45 minutes approximately.

Stage three - Carrbridge Hotspot, Grantown-on-Spey Hotspot, Grantown-on-Spey Hotspot, Boat of Garten Hotspot, Carrbridge Hotspot.

Stage four - NONE. Competition will be decided after Stage three.

"Monadhliath" Team Competition - Any three riders to count from a team of four riders, calculated on a stage by stage basis. Based on time - excluding bobuses.

Race format - Stages one, two and three are massed start road races.
Stage four is an individual Time Trial.

Competitors numbers will be from 1 to 60. Reserves 61 to 70.
ONLY 60 RIDERS START.

All riders wearing competition jerseys must also wear their race Nos.

Special notes on Stage two. One hour Criterium.

The normal laps out procedure for short circuits will apply. The Time-keeper will indicate when the boards are shown for the last 5 laps.

The race will end when winner crosses the finish line. Lapped riders times will be calculated on average lap times plus adjustments to place lapped riders behind the last rider to complete the full distance.

Riders will be adjudged to be lapped when overtaken by Lead Car.

Protests - Must be handed, in writing, to the Chief Commissaire, within 1 hour of Stage finishes. Protests regarding results must be handed, in writing, to the Chief Commissaire not less than 30 minutes prior to the start of the next stage.

Appeals - The Race Jury will comprise of the Organiser, Chief Judge and Chief Commissaire. Decisions by the Race Jury will be final.

Start - 19.00 Car Park, STAKIS Four Seasons Hotel.

Route - Round circular road at Aviemore Centre. The race will be neutralised from the car park, Stakis Four Seasons Hotel, for $\frac{3}{4}$ way round the 0.8 mile circular road to the official start at the Finish area.

Race Distance - One Hour

HOT SPOTS - at $\frac{1}{4}$ hour, $\frac{1}{2}$ hour and at $\frac{3}{4}$ hour.

STAGE FOUR

The Cairngorm Stage

Sunday 21 June.

Signing on - At least 20 minutes before departure at new RACE CONTROL at the WOODSHED BAR, Stakis Coylumbridge Resort Hotel.

First Man Off - 14.30 REVERSE GEN. CLASS. ORDER

Route - Start at Woodshed Bar within grounds of Hotel. GREAT CARE must be taken during the first 200 meters to leave the Hotel and turn left onto main road. Proceed on main road via Glenmore village and up the Ski Road via the one-way system to finish in car park at top of Ski Road.
Distance - 8 miles.
