

STAKIS TOUR OF SPEYSIDE STAGE DETAILS

STAGE 1. THE BADENOCH STAGE – sponsored by :-STAKIS Badenoch Hotel, Aviemore Centre.

Start 10.00am Saturday 16th June 1990 at the Aviemore Centre. B970 to Kincraig. B9152 to Kingussie. A86 to Newtonmore and Laggan. Unclassified road to Glentruim. A9 and B9150 to Newtonmore. A86 to Kingussie. B9152 to Kincraig, Aviemore to finish at Aviemore Centre — distance 50 miles

STAGE 2. THE CAIRNGORM STAGE – sponsored by :-Cairngorm Chairlift Company Ltd, Cairngorm.

Start 3.00pm Saturday 16th June 1990 at Coylumbridge Hotel. Finish at Ski Car Park, Mount Cairngorm. Individual Time Trial — distance 8 miles.

STAGE 3. THE STRATHSPEY STAGE – sponsored by :Beatrice Alpha Oilworkers.

Start 9.00am Sunday 17th June 1990 at Aviemore Centre. B9152, A95, B9153 to Carrbridge. A938, A95 to Grantown-on-Spey. B970 to Nethybridge. Detour past Loch Garten. B970 to Boat of Garten. A95 to Kinveachy. B9152 to Aviemore to finish at Aviemore Centre — distance 70 miles

STAGE 4. THE AVIEMORE STAGE – sponsored by :-STAKIS Four Seasons Hotel.

Start 3.00pm Sunday 17th June 1990 at the Aviemore Centre. Race round the 0.8 miles circular road within Aviemore Centre - distance 1 hour.

WHAT IS A MULTI-STAGE CYCLE RACE?

Well, the STAKIS Tour of Speyside is based on the Tour de France, albeit, a bit smaller.

Our race has four Stages - two on Saturday and two on Sunday. Each Stage is an independent race.

Stage one — the Badenoch Stage — sponsored by the STAKIS Badenoch Hotel, Aviemore Centre, is a 50 mile massed start road race. A maximum of 70 riders will start and prizes are won by the first four to finish. A time is recorded for every rider. The first three finishers are given a time bonus which is deducted for, their time (15 seconds for 1st. place, 10 seconds for 2nd. place and 5 seconds for 3rd. place). The rider with the least time becomes the Race Leader and is presented with a Yellow Jersey which he must wear in the next Stage.

Stage two — the Cairngorm Stage — sponsored by the Cairngorm Chairlift Company Ltd., is very different. This Stage is an 8 mile individual Time Trial where the riders start at one minute intervals and race against the clock from Coylumbridge Hotel to the Ski Car Park at Mount Cairngorm. No time bonuses are awarded on this Stage, only prizes for the four fastest.

The time taken to climb the mountain is added to the Stage one time to produce the General Classification. The rider with the least time becomes the Race Leader and another Yellow Jersey is presented.

Stage three — the Strathspey Stage — sponsored by the Oilworkers of the Beatrice Alpha Oilrig, is the longest Stage being a 70 mile massed start Road Race. Prizes and time bonuses are won by the first few riders and again the Stage times are added together to produce the 'Gen. Class.' and the Race Leader.

Stage four — the Aviemore Stage — sponsored by STAKIS Four Seasons Hotel, is run round the Aviemore Centre for one hour. The circular road will be closed to other traffic but should there be an emergency (fire or ambulance) the race would be stopped and the road opened. The race is a massed start with prizes and time bonuses awarded to the first few riders. Once the Race Officials have done their sums and produced the final 'Gen Class.' a worthy winner will emerge.

Two other competitions will be running during the race. The 'Osprey Challenge' points competition — sponsored by STAKIS Coylumbridge Resort Hotel, is an individual competition based on points won at select places during Stages one, three and four, and for the fastest times over the first five miles of Stage two. The Leader in the points competition can be recognised by the Green Jersey. Time bonuses are also awarded which go towards the 'Gen Class.' competition.

The other competition is the 'Monadhliath' team competition — sponsored by Coylumbridge Highland Lodges Timeshare Development. A team consists of four riders. The race times of the best three in every Stage are added together and the winners are the team having the least time after the four Stages.




