STAGE 1. THE BADENOCH STAGE – sponsored by:— STAKIS Coylumbridge Resort Hotel.

Start 10.00am Saturday 8th June 1996 at the Aviemore Centre. B970 to Kincraig. B9152 to Kingussie. A86 to Newtonmore and Laggan. Unclassified road to Glentrium. A9 and B9150 to Newtonmore. A86 to Kingussie. B9152 to Kincraig, Aviemore to finish at Aviemore Centre – distance 50 miles.

STAGE 2. THE CAIRNGORM STAGE – sponsored by:–
Cairngorm Chairlift Company Ltd, Cairngorm.

Start 3.00pm Saturday 8th June 1996 at Coylumbridge Hotel. Via B970 to Boat of Garten, A95 and B9152 to Aviemore, Coylumbridge Glenmore to finish in Ski Car Park, Cairngorm – distance 25 miles.

A95 to Kinveachy. B9153 to Carrbridge. A938 to Dulnain Bridge. A95 to Kinveachy. B9152 to Aviemore to finish at Aviemore Centre – distance 70 miles.

Start 3.00pm Sunday 9th June 1996 at the Aviemore Centre. Race round the 0.8 miles circular road with in Aviemore Centre – distance 1 hour.

WHAT IS A MULTI-STAGE CYCLE RACE?

Well, the STAKIS Tour of Speyside is based on the Tour de France, albeit, a bit smaller.

Our race has four Stages – two on Saturday and two on Sunday. Each Stage is an independent race.

Stage One – the Badenoch Stage – sponsored by the STAKIS Coylumbridge Resort Hotel, is a 50 miles massed start road race. A maximum of 100 riders will start and prizes are won by the first six to finish. A time is recorded for every rider. The first three finishers are given a time bonus which is deducted from their time (15 seconds for 1st. place, 10 seconds for 2nd. place and 5 seconds for 3rd. place). The rider with the least time becomes the Race Leader and is presented with a Yellow Jersey which he must wear in the next Stage.

Stage two – the Cairngorm Stage – sponsored by the Cairngorm Chairlift Company Ltd., is for the climbers. This stage is the shortest at 25 miles. The start is at the Stakis Coylumbridge Resort Hotel. A loop via Boat of Garten and Aviemore is covered before the climb to the finish at the Ski Car Park, Cairngorm. Time bonuses are won, the two stages are added together and the race leader gets his Yellow Jersey.

Stage three – the Strathspey Stage – sponsored by SCOTTISH CO-OP is the longest Stage being a 70 mile massed start Road Race. Prizes and time bonuses are won by the first few riders and again the Stage times are added together to produce the 'Glen. Class.' and the Race Leader.

Stage four – the Aviemore Stage – sponsored by Aviemore Mountain Resort, is run round the Centre for one hour. The circular road will be closed to other traffic but should there be an emergency (fire or ambulance) the race would be stopped and the road opened. The race is a massed start with prizes and time bonuses awarded to the first few riders. Once the Race Officials have done their sums and produced the final 'Gen. Class'. a worthy winner will emerge to claim the race winners Yellow Jersey presented by STAKIS AVIEMORE. A second Yellow Jersey will be won by the highest placed 3rd Category Rider – sponsored by Semple & Cochrane Limited, Paisely.

Two other competitions will be running during the race. The 'Osprey Challenge' points competition – sponsored by STAKIS Coylumbridge Timeshare, is an individual competition based on points won at selected places during all stages. The Leader in the points competition can be recognised by the Green Jersey. Time bonuses are also awarded which go towards the 'Gen. Class.' competition.

The other competition is the 'Monadhliath' team competition – sponsored by Badenoch and Strathspey Sports Council. A team consists of four riders. The race times of the best three in every Stage are added together and the winners are the team having the least time after the four Stages.
